- 3. Cross-curricular one-day workshop in Secondary (e.g. looking at MFL, CL, English & EAL) developing an intercultural perspective towards learning
- 4. Secondary team staff development: embedding EAL in Subject Studies
- In 2stages:
- 1. Raising the issues and auditing current subject practice
- sharing of good practice and developing a model to embed across subjects
- 5. (professional repertoire)
- **6. Goldsmiths teacher centre:** to develop a CPD module for practising teachers with a focus on EAL, languages and literacies
- 7. European **Regio** project MCMC (Meeting the challenges of the multicultural classroom) with Southwark and Algarve LAs and Primary/Secondary teachers: we want to include PGCE students in the project
- 8. Research into Multiliteracies: Secondary English and Languages classrooms with a focus on new digital literacies

Issues/ Challenges

- Embedding good practice in subject pedagogy (we already have some useful practice in terms of EAL in GPS modules, input from visiting speakers e.g. from LA and in on-line training materials for students)
- Ensuring equity and quality of trainee experience across the partnership

Actions

- Partnership development day involving school-based mentors, liaison tutors and university staff to exchange information about practice, to develop an action plan for enhancing training across the partnership – to invite experts to present at the development day
- Disseminate ideas and practices from this event to UG and PG staff to plan embedding of strategies and practices within subject modules
- During planning of re-validated primary UG programme to embed EAL from year 1 in Children's Development module

- through the spiral curriculum into each year's modules covering language and learning development
- To monitor embedding of EAL in subject modules on Secondary and Early Years PGCE
