- Encourages conversation & collaboration.
- Language skills acquired naturally.
- Specific sets of vocabulary introduced & consolidated.
- Promotes sense of unity & boosts individual self-esteem.
- Improves practical skills useful for literacy.

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- Provides real oral, interactive situation for assessment of spoken language.
- Practical & collaborative tasks enable different language functions to be observed.
